1. STUD FEE \$ _____ Payable by September 1 or _____
Booking fee of: \$ _____ which is not refundable and due when contract is signed
and is part of the breeding fee.
2. GUARANTEE: The Daehling Ranch guarantees a return breeding the following
season for this mare or an approved substitute mare, should a live foal not result from this
breeding. Death of a foal or still birth has to be certified by a Veterinarian within 10 days
of foaling date.
3. RELEASE OF LIABILITY: The Daehling Ranch is in no way responsible for any
accident, injury, or illness to the boarded mare, her foal on her side or a foal which is
born at the Daehling Ranch. The mare owner is in no way responsible for any accident,
injury, or illness of the stallion, the mare is being bred to.
4. CHARGES: All the bills including board, farrier, and veterinary shall be billed
monthly and are payable upon receipt. **All charges shall be paid in full before the mare
is moved from Daehling Ranch.** If the mare owner fails to pay any money due under
this agreement, a finance charge will be added to any unpaid balance. The mare owner
agrees to pay all cost of collection including reasonable attorney fees.
5. STALLION AVAILABILITY: Should the stallion become unfit for service before
breeding the mare, this contract shall become void.
6. BOARDING: The undersigned agrees that the attached Boarding Agreement and Fee
schedule have been read and understood and are part of this contract. The daily rate shall
